7th July - 16th July 2022 Szeged, Hungary

Call for Participation

The **Summer School on Image Processing** aims to provide a stimulating opportunity for graduate and PhD students interested in image processing. The 30th edition will be held between **July 7 and 16, 2022**, in **Szeged, Hungary**, organized by the Department of Image Processing and Computer Graphics, University of Szeged. Participants will benefit from direct interaction with internationally renowned researchers in various fields of image processing and computer vision as well as from interacting with fellow participants from all over the world. Students will also have the possibility to present their own research in a short talk. The established tradition of SSIP is that, in addition to morning lectures, students work on a project assignment in international teams, which are then evaluated by a committee of lecturers on the last day. Students will receive a certificate of attending the Summer School and passing the exam, which is recognized as a special PhD course by several universities.

Application: The school is open to about 50 motivated and pre-selected candidates. Graduate and PhD students, post-docs and young researchers (both from academia and industry) are encouraged to apply.

CEEPUS scholarship: A limited number of CEEPUS grants will be available for students and teachers. The reduced scholarships will be HUF 95 000 for students and HUF 115 000 for teachers. *The application must be arranged with the organizers before submission.* **CEEPUS applicants should take into account that their grants depend on the success of the organizer's application for the SSIP CEEPUS support, which is still pending.**

Student Session: SSIP provides the opportunity for participants to present their research in short talks. Please submit your proposal along with your registration.

SSIP 2022 is organized as a hybrid event. Lecturers and students may choose to participate on this event in person or online. The CEEPUS participants – according to our current knowledge – cannot receive virtual scholarship in the given period. If the epidemiological situation would change dramatically, SSIP 2022 will proceed in fully online mode.

Accommodation: Participants can arrange their accommodation by themselves. We offer a limited number of places in a student hostel for a moderate price. The hostel is nicely located in the city center.

Costs:

Registration fee*:	EUR 150
Online participation registration fee**:	EUR 70
Accommodation in double/single rooms in the student hostel*:	HUF 4 750/6 000 (/person/night)
A set meal in the university canteens:	ca. HUF 1 700

*CEEPUS scholarship holders are exempt from the registration fee and accommodation fee. CEEPUS scholarship holders will be accommodated in double rooms. **CEEPUS applicants should take into account that their fees depend on the success of the organizer's application for the SSIP CEEPUS support, which is still pending.**

**With online participation you will receive the access to the online lectures, and materials. Online participants will also be involved in the team work and finally will receive the certificates about SSIP 2022 if they satisfy the conditions.
